Hands on Heritage CIO Covid 19 Guidelines for site maintenance activities - update March 2021

If you have any symptoms stay at home, isolate and call NHS 111. Do not come to site if you feel unsafe doing so; please act to best protect your health at all times.

- When invited please get vaccinated by the NHS
- Only a maximum of 6 *pre-booked* fully briefed HoH volunteers to be onsite at any time. Please advise Maintenance Lead Jonathan Roots in advance by email to confirm your attendance.
- Please remain vigilant for members of the public entering the site, to
 ensure they do not present a risk. If necessary, politely ask them to
 stay outside the working area. Be prepared to stop work and leave the
 area until safe if necessary. HoH volunteers identified by HiVis vests.
- Anyone on site from different households to remain at least 2m apart at all times. Remain familiar with and practice the latest Government and Public Health England Covid 19 Guidance. Do not share transport.
- Please bring your own hand sanitizer (min 70% alcohol), gloves, and face covering for personal use. Please sanitize hands thoroughly before eating or drinking anything.
- Please bring your own food and drink in sealed containers. Please do not share or leave it uncovered.
- Wear a face covering to help avoid touching the face and to reduce the risk of transmission if you have to move closer to others, for example passing materials to other volunteers.
- Please ensure there is a bleach solution available for wiping down and sanitizing surfaces and tools. Bleach is stored in the garage.
- Do not share tools. If it is unavoidable, please sanitize tools carefully before handing them over, and when you have finished using them. Consider wearing gloves only whilst working. Sanitize hands after taking off gloves.
- Please sanitize your hands before entering and leaving the site, and regularly during your stay.
